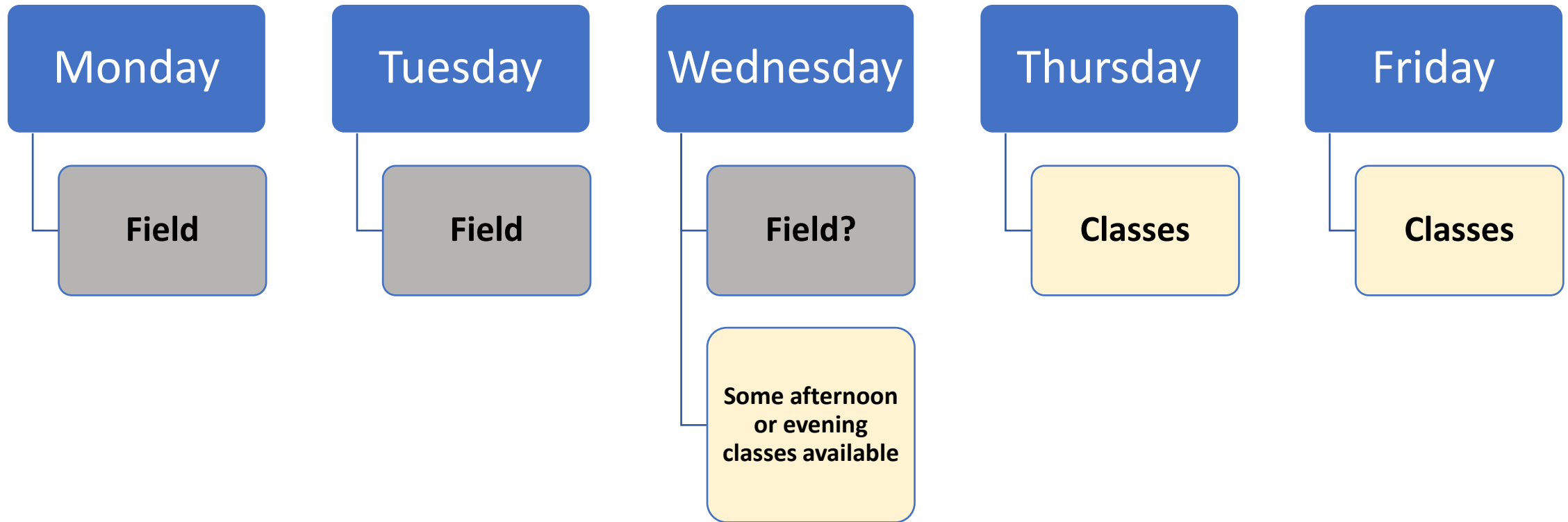


FALL 2023 CONCENTRATION CURRICULUM

Advanced Social Work Practice Concentration



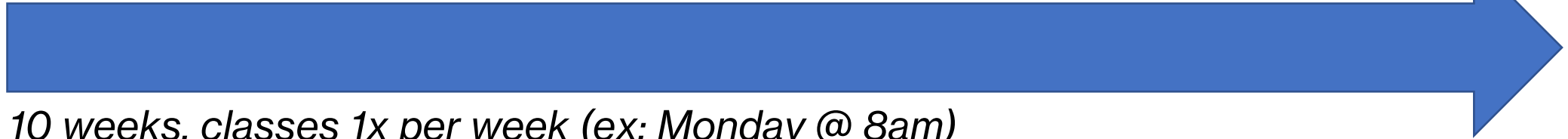
04. What to Expect: Sample fall/winter/spring schedule (10-week quarter)

Field = 10 weeks

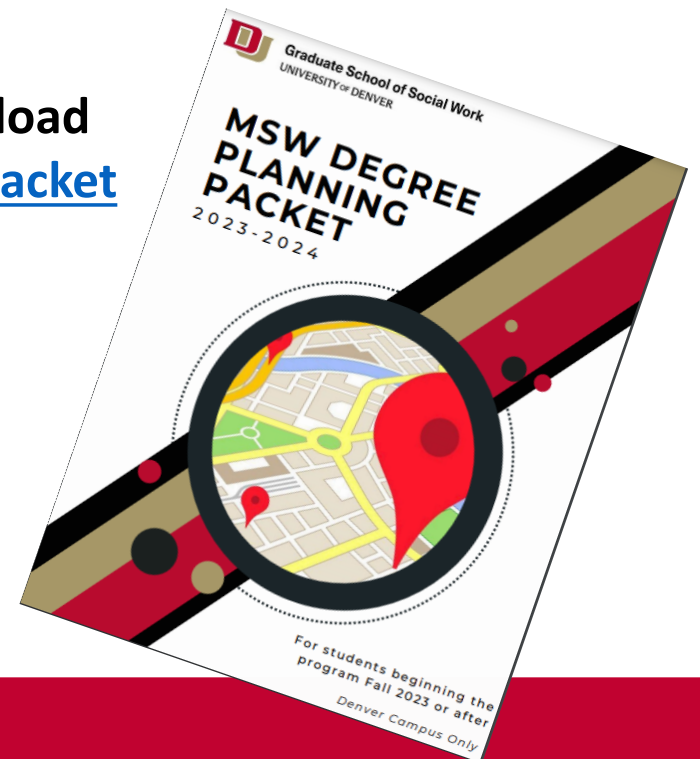

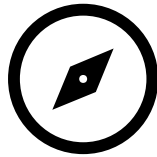
